

27. ESTONIAN OPEN MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS INVITATION 2016

- The Championships will be held on 3rd of December 2016 in Oismäe swimming pool
 Nõmme swimming pool (Vabaduse pst. 156, Tallinn http://tsh.ee/eng/924/)
- The competition will be organized by Estonian Swimming Federation in collaboration with Meisterujumise U-Klubi (contact Kristiina Arusoo, tel. 56656831)
- The participants must have a valid swimmers license of Estonian Swimming Federation or any other national swimming federation affiliated to FINA.
- The competition will be swum within one session in a 25 m indoor pool with 6 lanes.
- Electronic time-keeping shall be used.
- Entries should be sent at latest on **23rd of November 2016. a.** to e-mail <u>u-klubi@u-klubi.com</u> Please use the official entry form (App. 1) and all entries should be sent through clubs!
- Entry fee is 6 euros for one start.
 - When participating in all five events the entry fee shall be 24 euros.
- Entry fees should be paid at latest on 28th of November to bank account of EESTI UJUMISLIIT, EE142200221002100431
 - As explanation please use: MASTERS + name of club or swimmer. Swimmers from countries with other currency then euro can pay their entry fees before the competition in cash.
- FINA rules and the general competition rules of Estonian Swimming Federation for 2016 / 17 season are valid.
- Awards ceremony will be held 30 min after the competition on the 2nd floor of Nõmme swimming pool. Party with dinner and dance will be at the cafe of Eesti Energia, Kadaka tee 63. Beginning ~18:00. Please register to party at latest on 28th of November. Ticket 25 EUR. (should be paid before the competition in cash).

Events:

50 m Freestyle W; M 50 m Breaststroke W; M 50 m Butterfly W; M 50 m Backstoke W; M 100 m Ind. Medley W; M

Schedule:

Start of the competitions at 12:00, warm-up at 11:15. Race-office is open from 11:00. After each event there will be approx. 10 min brake.

Age groups:

FINA masters age groups (swimmers with year of birth 1991 and earlier). The age of competitor is determined by December 31st 2016.

Awards:

Diplomas will be given to all swimmers. Medals will be awarded to swimmers placed in TOP 3 within one's age group at least in one event (one medal per person). Special ranking using age coefficients will be calculated for "Supermaster" title (50 m in all disciplines +100 m IM). The first 6 men and women in Supermaster ranking will be awarded with medals.
